## Entry Submission, Entry Withdrawal & Closing Date

- It is open to all foreign and local players not banned by the WSF/ASF and SSRA
- Players can enter up to 2 categories. Players who do so may be expected to play back to back matches due to tight scheduling. **Postponement will be strictly prohibited.**
- Please give your correct date of birth. We will verify them with your passport
- Tournament Secretariat must be notified of any withdrawal with valid reasons. Entry fees will not be refunded if withdrawal is done after closing date

- Registration must be received before **1<sup>ST</sup> October 2019 1159pm Singapore Time**. Late entries will not be accepted

## Scoring & Format

- Tournament will be played using monrad/circuit format. Round robin format may be used in the event of a small number of entries in a particular category.
- Main rounds and top 8 matches will be played to best of 5 games, other positions will be dependent on draw size.
- Scoring - 11 points – PAR (Point-A-Rally) following the WSF Rules of World Singles Game
- Depending on the number of entries in each category, format will be determined by SSRA.
- All players are guaranteed **A MINIMUM OF 2 MATCHES**.
- Check-in 45mins before scheduled match time. Match timing is an indication only. Matches will be played on a **FOLLOW-ON-BASIS** (matches will be called to start when the preceding match ends). **Postponement of match will not be entertained.**
- Walkover will be awarded against players who are more than 15 minutes late upon being called to start the match; subsequent matches will be forfeited; no points and rankings will be awarded unless a valid MC is produced **and** prior notice to organizer is given.
- Players may be expected to play two matches a day.

## Code of Conduct
